FAQ's

Where is this camp held?

United Christian Youth Camp, 1400 Paradise Valley Rd, Prescott, AZ

How will children get to Summer Camp?

Children will ride to camp on charter buses driven by licensed professional drivers.

How much extra money should my son/daughter bring?

If children would like to spend money in the snack shop on souvenirs and snacks, you can add store money in their camp registration that will be held on to by their adult leader. Any leftover store money will be donated to camp.

What if my son/daughter takes regular prescription medication?

- Medication needs to be checked in to our camp nurse on the day of departure.
- Students may not carry **any medication** except for an inhaler. This includes allergy, sinus, and pain medication. If your student has an additional inhaler, we prefer for the nurse to have that checked-in to them as a back-up.
- Medications **must** come in their **original container** with **accurate instructions**.
- Our camp nurse will have a basic first aid kit for minor illnesses or injuries. Should we need to take your son/daughter to the hospital, your family will be contacted.

Packing List

- Bible
- Notebook & pen/pencil
- One duffel bag/suitcase
- Bedding: sleeping bag or sheet/blanket, pillow
- Clothing for the week
- Athletic/Color Wars attire for rec time (See Color Wars information below)
- Sunscreen, modest swimsuit, hat
- Toiletries: soap, shampoo, deodorant, toothbrush, toothpaste, etc.
- Two towels – One for showering; One for the pool
- **No cell phones. No electronic devices. No weapons of any kind. No candy or food of any kind. No pets/animals. *These items will be confiscated if found*.**

Central Christian Church is not liable for lost or stolen property. Any weapons, alcohol, or illegal substances are prohibited.

Dress Code

Modesty is key.

Girls, please do not bring spaghetti strap tank tops, low-cut shirts, crop tops, or short shorts. Bring a modest swimsuit (one-piece suits are highly encouraged).

Guys, please do not wear saggy pants, short shorts, or exposed boxers.

What is Color Wars?

Color Wars is our team games and recreation time at camp. Pack as much stuff as you can to represent your team's color at Color Wars (face paint, sweat bands, capes, knee socks, accessories, etc.)

Are Cell Phones allowed at camp?

UCYC has a strict "no cell phone" policy at camp. If your son or daughter finds it necessary to bring their phone, it will be turned in to an adult leader for the duration of the week, and will be returned once everyone is loaded on the bus to head home. **This goes for ALL electronic devices** (i.e. iPods, MP3 players, portable gaming systems, DVD players, GPS, etc.).

Camp Counselors (Adult Leaders)

All of our children are cared for by interviewed and background checked/cleared Christian adults from Central Christian Church. These adults specifically have a heart to serve and mentor children. They will stay with the children in the cabins, eat meals together, participate in rec-time together, and experience group time together. A specific adult will be assigned to your son/daughter's group. Our adults are a part of this trip to keep your son/daughter safe and to also help them in their journey of faith. We provide a one-to-eight ratio of leaders to children (one adult per eight children).

Camp Rules

1. Respect others and yourself.
2. No girls in guys' cabins, and no guys in girls' cabins.
3. No PDA (public or private displays of affection).
4. Alcohol, drugs, tobacco, fireworks, and weapons are absolutely prohibited (students will be sent home at the parent/guardian's expense).
5. Stay off the golf course next to the Camp. Children found trespassing on the golf course are subject to a \$500 fine (to be paid for at the parent's expense).
6. Everyone must be in their cabins by the designated "Cabin Time".
7. Follow the schedule. (Be where you're supposed to be when you are supposed to be there).
8. Do not leave the auditorium once the camp speaker begins talking.
9. Respect the camp grounds – no TP, water balloons, shaving cream, sidewalk chalk, etc. No practical jokes/pranks!
10. Students are not allowed to leave camp grounds without expressed parental permission.
11. Follow the dress code.
12. No Portable Electronic Devices. This includes, but is not limited to:
 - Cell Phones
 - iPods/MP3 Players
 - DVD Players
 - Computers
 - Handheld Gaming Devices
 - GPS
