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## Ministry Descriptions

**Business Administration** – A variety of support ministries at Central, including security, IT, finances and accounting. A resident in this ministry will receive a well-rounded view of church administration.

**Campus Ministries** – Central is a multi-site church, and thus has teams of people dedicated to ministry on each specific campus. A resident in this ministry will work alongside an Associate Campus Pastor at a specific campus of Central to support and execute ministry on the campus.

**Children's Ministry** – Taking children (birth-sixth grade) on an adventure with Jesus through weekend services, fun events, and camps.

**Connections** – A variety of ministries including serving first time guests, those who want to connect with Central and start serving, evangelism, and community outreach. The emphasis for a resident entering into this ministry would primarily be community outreach.

**Global Outreach** – Raising thousands to reconcile millions to restore shalom. Most of GO's work is done through local refugee work, immersion trips (locally and abroad) to introduce people to a different story/culture, and developing and mobilizing people to be goers, either long-term or short-term mission workers.

**Graphic Design** – Creating visuals to communicate Central's message in graphic form, including series graphics, event promotion, logos and branding.

**Information Technology** – Providing computer and telecommunications support to Central's staff and campuses, and creating connections through Central's database.

**Life Groups** – Connecting the people of Central to small groups for community and discipleship, and resourcing the small group leaders.

**Marketing** – Using gifts and talents in web design, social media, content creation, videography, and graphic design to help people outside the body of Christ discover who Jesus is, and fully own their faith in Him.

**Pastoral Care** – Resourcing and ministering to people during life's tougher challenges—includes life care classes, hospital visitations, and funerals.

**Production** – Creating environments for people to discover and fully own faith in Jesus. Supporting ministries by ensuring video, audio, and lighting are working correctly in all areas.

**Programming** – Participating in the creative process and the development of weekend services. Creates some content (visual and verbal) for the weekend experience, and then resources and communicates to all teams involved in the execution of the weekend experience.





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**Student Ministry** – Leading students (seventh-twelfth grade) to discover and fully own faith in Jesus through challenging and engaging messages, live worship, interactive life groups, midweek bible studies, fun events, global trips and summer camps.

**Video** – The creation of visual storytelling and media. Working on a variety of projects, including series bumpers, creative elements, teaching videos, and testimonials.

**Women's Ministry** – Helping women discover and fully own their faith in Jesus through intentional discipleship and outreach opportunities, bible studies, and leadership development. The staff builds strong teams with leadership opportunities, writing curriculum, and hosting events and conferences of all sizes.

**Worship/Music** – Leading the people of Central to glorify God through worship and music, and resourcing the volunteers in the ministry.
