Post-Rooted Study Curriculum via YouVersion App

Rooted develops bonds with other believers and deepens our relationships within the Body of Christ. It tangibly demonstrates the foundation of Christian living in 10 weeks. We learned that God is eternal, so what is 10 weeks if a lifetime is just a mist? It is important to practice the 7 Rooted Rhythms – <u>Daily Devotion, Prayer, Freedom for Strongholds, Sacrificial Generosity, Serve the Community, Share Your Story, and Celebration</u> – and make them into habits that last a lifetime. As your Life Group continues your normal rhythm of life, please consider that God's Word teaches us to follow Him closely, that He is a jealous God who desires for His children to be in close relationship with Him and obey His Word. Being a follower of God requires discipline, which is the root of the word discipleship, which is in turn a derivative of the word commonly used to describe those who wish to be known as followers of God – disciples.

The following curriculum is fluid and allows you to follow wherever the Holy Spirit leads. It is designed only to reinforce and begin to establish into habit the 7 Rooted Rhythms. Each Rooted Rhythm is addressed in these segments. Please consider participating in one study from each segment, then repeating the process. It is highly unlikely that the material becomes boring, irrelevant, or repetitive, because one can read the Bible every day and learn something new. Being open to new perspectives is key to maintaining enthusiasm for learning about God. He is infinite in every way, and we are not (except in Him); therefore, we have much to learn if we will remain humble and open to His tutelage.

1. Who Is God?

a. In any relationship, the bond of trust develops over time and shared experiences; therefore, we who believe in Jesus as our Savior, Redeemer, and Lord need to spend time getting to know who God is – His character, His attributes, and His actions. God is immense, and His essence is beyond or comprehension. He is omniscient, omnipresent, and omnipotent – all of which describe Him in terms we cannot completely come to understand in this life. He has revealed Himself to us through His revelations – Creation, His Word, and His experiences with us. To the extent that He has revealed Himself to us, we can gain some level of understanding of who He is and how to respond to God. For these and many other reasons, we want to know Him better to further develop our relationship with Him. That is why it is important to continue to learn more and more about who God is and to never be satisfied with what we currently know about God, but to press further into our relationship with Him.

2. Prayer

a. The relationships in which we constructively invest our time and energy will continue to grow, develop, and mature. Prayer is talking with God! Yes, it is that simple! Speaking with God as you would speak with your best friend is developing your relationship with God. Sharing your triumphs, joys, difficulties, and hardships like you would with your best friend is prayer – only with God. And just as we cannot have one-sided conversations with our best friend and learn about them, we must listen to what God says to us and take keen interest in what He instructs, because He is the Creator of the universe. He designed everything and works all things for good for those who believe. Listen is good, but we won't have a best friend very long if we do not value their input. It is the same with God. No one knows better. No one else is qualified to tell us the best path in all situations. Therefore, it is not only important to listen, but

also to obey His instruction to us, His guidance for our well-being, and to recognize that He is our Heavenly Father, eternally faithful, and faithfully loving of His children.

3. Scripture/Devotions

a. God's Word is His special revelation to His people. As believers, we trust that God's Word is divinely inspired. It provides the greatest teachings known to humanity, foretold of many things that have occurred throughout history and foretells of many more to come. It stands to reason that we would want to immerse ourselves in what God is sharing with us through His revelation to us – to learn of Him, the plans He has for us, and His Kingdom that we have been called into by our belief in Jesus.

Gospel means "Good News", and each of these accounts of the life and actions of Jesus is indeed good news to those who believe in Jesus. There are 61 more books of the Bible to study and there are multiple studies of each in the YouVersion App. Explore, discover, learn, and develop your relationship with God through study of His Word.

4. Adversity/Hardship/Suffering

- a. The reality of this world is that pain and suffering occur, sometimes with no apparent reason or justification. We see it every day if we watch the news and all of us experience it in our lifetime. Rooted addressed this issue with four responses:
 - i. We Are Not Alone
 - ii. Double-Fisted Faith
 - iii. Our Response: Surrender
 - iv. Character Like Christ

Each of these daily studies opens the door to any number of YouVersion App studies. Search "adversity" in the plans section of the app and find dozens of studies on several types of adversity in various facets of life – work, parenting, personal struggles, etc. Likewise, searches using key words like "faith", "surrender", "submit", and "character", as well as studies in the "Who Is God?" section of this outline provide examples of how to overcome the world and live in the peace of our Savior.

As you pray for each of the members of your Life Group, ask God to show you which areas He wants to use the vast resources in the YouVersion App to work in the lives of your group members to bring healing, overcoming, and growth into their lives and yours.

5. There Is An Enemy

a. We inherently understand that there is a villain in every movie, play, story, or life, and sometimes, we take a liking to the villain in the story, because they are adventurous or maybe even a little dangerous and thrilling. However, we often neglect to take into account the reason they are the villain. Jesus tells us that the devil wants to steal, kill, and destroy. It's harder to have high regard for someone like that when we examine their actions. Too often Christians neglect to recognize the damage done by the presence of the enemy in our lives. This rhythm addresses our collective weaknesses head on, by encouraging us to come together with the Holy Spirit in opposition to the enemy. Rooted introduced us to this rhythm/discipline, and now it is time to develop our understanding and ability to cast out the enemy's influence in our lives!

6. How Can I Make the Most of My Life?

a. God is the Creator of the universe, and He knitted each of us in the womb. His infinite knowledge, understanding, and wisdom in all that He has created begs us to listen to His direction for the best solution to what we should do in our lives, what purpose we should fulfill as members of His Kingdom. To that end, there are many studies on spiritual gifts that help identify our gifts, and how we can use our gifts.

In addition, God is very specific about some of the people we should help — orphans, widows, and the poor. While the world readily labels and identifies people as orphans, widows, and poor, those labels are less important than how God sees people. Part of the challenge of helping people is finding the ones that truly need and want help, whether they know it or not. The Holy Spirit is very helpful in identifying who and how to help those that God wants us to come along side.

7. How Does God View Money?

a. "The love of money is a root of all sorts of evil..." – 1Timothy 6:10a. This verse and its many misquoted derivations comes up frequently when we study finances. It is an inescapable reality! Money is a powerful idol in the lives of many. That is why it is vital to learn how to relate to it and manage it. We are stewards of what God has given us; therefore, we cannot ignore money, but need to manage it properly.

We are the image of God, and through the process of sanctification, we are becoming more like Him as we mature. God is incredibly generous with us, so it follows that we should be generous with others.

a. Rooted helped refine our story into something we can share. It also teaches us to seek out opportunities to share our story with others. The Rooted Experience may have been the first time you had the confidence to share your story with others, but it should definitely not be the last time! Our story changes with time, because God continues to transform us into His image, so our story has to change along with the changes in our lives to remain authentic. Fortunately, this is not something we need to do frequently – a couple of times each year is usually plenty, but it is a great rhythm to practice, so we are always prepared to defend our faith when asked about it.

9. Celebration!

a. This rhythm is easy for some, or just not something that others think of practicing. So allow those who excel in this rhythm to help others see and experience the joy of regular celebration of what God is doing. Paul listed joy among the fruits of the Spirit in Galatians 5:22, and joy seems like the most appropriate response to salvation's gift!

Rhythms and habits develop from fruitful practice, and while one can develop these rhythms through individual study, the depth and breadth of experience gained while sharing and listening to the perspectives of fellow believers, like in a Life Group increases our understanding in ways that our individual experiences cannot achieve. Practicing the 7 Rhythms taught in Rooted will position each of us to deepen our relationship with the Father and thereby increase our abilities to share His Kingdom riches with others.
