 <p>BIG IDEA</p>	<p>Your legacy is the difference your life made to those who come after you.</p>

His belief in God's promises led to blessings for the whole world through Jesus. ● Jesus left the legacy of salvation and the Church. ● The All In initiative aims to increase our capacity, effectiveness, and commitment to that mission.
