BIG IDEA

Generosity is part of our spiritual growth. Everything we have belongs to God, and learning to steward it with open hands leads to greater joy, freedom, and impact for eternity.



ICE BREAKER

MAIN POINTS

- Stewardship changes how we see everything - Psalm 24:1
- You reap what you sow. When we sow generosity, we experience a harvest of joy.
- God looks at the heart, not the amount.
- Generosity grows over time, we grow into it step by step.
- Generosity Journey, new giver, consistent giver, intentional giver, catalytic giver.



DISCUSS

1. Why do you think the Bible talks about money and stewardship so often?
2. Which part of the generosity journey do you relate to the most right now?
3. Why can trusting God with money feel difficult?
4. How have you seen generosity bring joy or freedom in someone's life?
5. What might be your next step toward greater generosity?



NEXT STEP

This week, take one step forward in generosity:

Money deceives us and tells us we are better on top.

- Give for the first time.
- Begin giving consistently.
- Decide on a percentage to give intentionally.
- Pray and ask God how your resources can impact His mission.

Challenge: Don't wait until you "have more." Start with what you have. How do we become catalytic givers so that others can know and become closer to Jesus.
