






 <p>SERIES & TITLE</p>	<p>JESUS MANIFESTO - Blessed are the Pure in Heart</p>
 <p>BIG IDEA</p>	<p>Purity of heart leads to clarity.</p>
 <p>ICE BREAKER</p>	<p>Share about a time when you couldn't see clearly (physically or metaphorically) and how it affected you. How did things change when your vision was restored or the situation became clear?</p>
 <p>MAIN POINTS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Purity leads to clarity ● Spiritual purity is having eyes for God ● Purity is not achieved; it is received ● Purity should be pursued
 <p>DISCUSS</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. What most stood out to you from the message this week? 2. What does it mean to you to have "eyes for God" in all areas of your life? In what areas do you find this most challenging? 3. Pastor Shan emphasizes that God cares more about the condition of our hearts than our outward behaviors. How does this perspective change the way you think about sin and righteousness? 4. Pastor Shan suggests an exercise of writing down areas of sin or struggle and confessing them to God. How do you think this practice could impact your spiritual growth? Are you willing to try it this week? 5. What are some practical ways you can "fill up" with Jesus in your daily life? Which of these do you want to commit to this week? 6. How does the concept of receiving purity rather than achieving it change your approach to spiritual growth? 7. Pastor Shan mentions that purity is about more than just sexuality. In what other areas of your life do you feel God calling you to pursue purity?
 <p>NEXT STEP</p>	<p>Choose one thing this week you will do to begin filling up with good:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Reading a chapter a day (Pastor Shan recommends Proverbs - 31 chapters for 31 days) ● 5 minutes of prayer ● Join a group
 <p>SCRIPTURE</p>	<p>Matthew 5:8 - Blessed are the pure in heart, for they will see God.</p> <p>1 John 1:9 - If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness.</p>
