What prevents the gap between knowing and doing?</li> <li>What's one truth from Scripture you already know, but struggle to live out consistently?</li> <li>On a scale of 1-10, how would you rate the current state of your relationships? Is your life feeling full of community, or more isolated?</li> <li>Pastor Cal shared about his dogs Scout and Millie - they had opposite temperaments but helped each other thrive. How can people with different personalities strengthen each other in community?</li> <li>What would need to change in your current lifestyle to make deeper community a priority?</li> </ol>
