









## **WEEKEND RECAP DISCUSSION GUIDE**

 <p><b>SERIES &amp; TITLE</b></p>	LOVE BEYOND...By Being Selfless
 <p><b>BIG IDEA</b></p>	Overcome selfishness and self centeredness by living selflessly in Christ-centered community like the early church.
 <p><b>ICE BREAKER</b></p>	What is one of your favorite meals you've shared with others? What made it meaningful?
 <p><b>MAIN POINTS</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● Christianity isn't a solo sport! This passage emphasizes the communal nature of the early church - the words "they," "together," etc</li><li>● The believers were "devoted" to spiritual practices like teaching, fellowship, communion, and prayer.</li><li>● A key theme in this passage is selflessness - selling possessions to give to the needy, worshipping together, etc.</li><li>● Because of the believers' selflessness and devotion, God added daily to their number.</li></ul>
 <p><b>DISCUSS</b></p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. What most stood out to you about this message today?</li><li>2. What are some of the benefits of doing our faith together in community rather than individually? What are some challenges?</li><li>3. In what ways are you devoted to your faith or spiritual growth? What other areas could use more devotion?</li><li>4. How could our church become more "others-focused" and make more of a difference in our community?</li><li>5. In what ways do you struggle with selfishness? How could you become more selfless in serving others?</li></ol>
