MAIN POINTS

- The first "not good" in the Bible is that it is not good to do life alone.
- Many people are experiencing a "crisis of connection" with fewer close relationships.
- Humility is crucial for maintaining healthy relationships and personal growth.
- Pride can prevent us from listening to valuable input from others.
- It's important to have people in our lives who will tell us what we need to hear, not just what we want to hear.



DISCUSS

1. Sociologists say that the number and depth of relationships is on the decline. Have you noticed this in society? In your own life?
2. What most stood out to you from the message this weekend?
3. Discuss the concept of "self-serving bias" in your own words. How might this affect our relationships and personal growth?
4. How do you typically respond when someone gives you feedback or criticism? Does it depend on who it is? Who do you respond best to?
5. Pastor Cal said, "The more you don't want to listen, the more you should!" Why do you think this is true, and how can we put it into practice?
6. Reflect on the story of Nebuchadnezzar. What lessons can we learn from his experience about pride and the importance of listening to wise counsel?
7. How can we cultivate humility in our lives and become more open to feedback from others?
